### Getting There

The **Blue Lakes** can be reached by taking **Blue Lakes Road** off of [Highway 88](#) near [Carson Pass](#). Follow this road for 20 miles and make a right at the sign directing you to **Blue Lakes**. There are two **Blue Lakes**, **Upper Blue Lake** and **Lower Blue Lake**.
