

## **Getting There**

The **Blue Lakes** can be reached by taking **Blue Lakes** Road off of Highway 88 near Carson Pass. Follow this road for 20 miles and make a right at the sign directing you to **Blue Lakes**. There are two **Blue Lakes**, **Upper Blue Lake** and **Lower Blue Lake**. We chose to fish the **Lower Blue Lake**. Follow the narrow road past the campgrounds and search for good spots to park and get out.

#### The Hike

These roadside waters at **Lower BLue Lake** and **Upper Blue Lake** do not require hiking. There may be a hike in your future if you want to venture onto the other side(s) of the **Blue Lakes**. The **Blue Lakes** in Alpine County offer an excellent place to launch your canoe or float tube.

## The Fishing

We wanted to do some relaxing fishing on a cool October morning at **The Blue Lakes**. So we used various colors of powerbait and perched along the east shore working each area for 15 minutes or so. Eventually we worked our way up to the north shore of **Lower Blue Lake** without getting any action. They must have been interested in something else. We accepted our defeat and headed home.
